## AM | ELIGIBLE?

In order to submit an eligible Chevening Scholarship application, you must:

- Be a citizen of a Chevening-eligible country or territory, and agree to return there for a minimum of two years after completing your scholarship
- Have completed an undergraduate degree that will enable you to gain entry to a postgraduate programme at a UK university
- Have at least two years' work experience
- Not have previously studied in the UK through a UK governmentfunded scholarship

There is no upper age limit.

#### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



All candidates are informed of the status of their applications. The strongest candidates are interviewed.



Interviewed candidates are notified of whether they have been conditionally selected, are on a reserve list, or are not being progressed.



Selected and reserve candidates must have received an unconditional offer for at least one of their three master's course choices to remain eligible.



Successful applicants commence their studies in the UK as Chevening Scholars.
