





EXTENSION OF PAPER SUBMISSION DATES FOR 2nd INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS EDUCATION

Reports on the situation of education in Ethiopia in the last two and half decades indicated wider access but deteriorating quality. Particularly students' performance, as evidenced from national examination results, on mathematics and science subjects are found to be the lowest in most cases. The situation is not exception in many developing countries, like South Sudan. As a joint project, Bahir Dar University (Ethiopia), University of Juba (South Sudan), and Norwegian University of Science and Technology (Norway) are working on the issue of improving the quality of science and mathematics teaching and learning in schools. Part of the project is to create platforms in which researchers, teachers, experts and policy makers involved in science and mathematics education come together and share experiences. With this intention the BDU-NORHED Project office at the College of Education and Behavioral Sciences, Bahir Dar University is organizing the **SECOND** international conference on Science and Mathematics Education with the theme of *Science and Mathematics Teaching, Learning and Assessment: Lessons from theory and practice.* The conference will be held on the **16**th & **17**th of December **2022** at the main campus of Bahir Dar University. Thus, we call for papers focusing on issues of:

- a. Contextualizing teaching and learning of science and mathematics
- b. Teacher preparation and professional development in science and mathematics teaching
- c. Technology and the teaching and learning of science and mathematics
- d. Alignment of learning and assessment in science and mathematics teaching
- e. Curricular issues in science and mathematics education
- f. Learners' conceptions and misconceptions in learning science and mathematics
- g. Equity and inclusion in mathematics and science education
